Led, completed and implemented a strategic plan. Re-invigorated the senior management team, managed day to day operations and focused the organization on key strategic initiatives. Introduced a new positioning as the "urban gateway to nature and science," and expanded our audience base, resulting in moving the Museum into

6th place (up two places) in attendance rankings for Chicago's Museums in the Park. Mobilized 44 Trustees around 6 key revenue initiatives, leading to a strengthened financial position. Achieved record fundraising results, with new individual, corporate and foundation partners and supporters. In the last two years, rallied the Board and staff around a 2024 planning process to identify long term goals, resulting in new energy and plans for the future, and the initiation of a major comprehensive capital campaign.
