After a decade leading Museum Education at the Art Institute of Chicago, RH took early retirement to accept a senior research fellowship at Harvard University's Center for the Study of World Religions. Her leadership in the field of the arts and public policy has included significant international consultancies and fellowships at the Aspen Institute, the Goethe Institut, and the Rockefeller Foundation's Bellagio Center.
