Susan S. Sher is the Executive Vice President for Corporate Strategy and Public Affairs at the University of Chicago Medical Center and Senior Adviser to the President of the University. Previously, she served in the White House as Assistant to the President and Chief of Staff to First Lady Michelle Obama where she was also Liaison to the Jewish Community. She also served as Associate White House Counsel, where she worked on health care reform and legal issues relating to the First Lady's office. Before going to Washington D.C., she was the Vice President for Legal and Governmental Affairs and General Counsel of the University of Chicago Medical Center. Previously she was the Corporation Counsel for the City of Chicago, the City of Chicago's chief lawyer, reporting to the Mayor. Earlier, she was a partner at Mayer Brown & Platt, specializing in Labor and Litigation.

She currently sits on the Boards of Loyola University of Chicago (Health Sciences Committee); the Chicagoland Chamber of Commerce (Vice Chair, Public Policy Committee); the Partnership for a Healthier America; and the National Advisory Board of ONE Vote.
