Thea Flaum had a 35-year-career as an award-winning producer of television series and specials. She created Sneak Previews, the movie-review show featuring Roger Ebert and Gene Siskel, as well as many other series and specials for national broadcast, cable and syndication.

She is currently the president of the Hill Foundation for Families Living with Disabilities, a non-profit organization founded by Thea Flaum and her husband, Robert A. Hill. The foundation has created FacingDisability.com, a web resource for people with spinal cord injuries and their families which features more than 3,000 videos drawn from interviews of people with spinal cord injuries, their families, caregivers and experts.

She is a member of the boards of the Media Burn video archive, the Ruth Page Foundation, the Shirley Ryan Abilitylab, the National Advisory Board of the Model Systems Knowledge Translation Center, and the Advisory Board of the Midwest Regional Spinal Cord Injury System.
