Vicki Dudley joined TTX Company in 2012 as Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer. At TTX, Vicki's responsibilities include accounting and financial reporting, tax, treasury, rating agency and investor relations, capital raising and capital allocation, insurance and risk management including enterprise risk management, and financial planning and analytics.

Co., the Caterpillar, Blue Bird Bus and International Truck dealer for Georgia, which provides sales, leasing and service for heavy construction and electric power equipment, buses and trucks. Ms. Dudley currently serves as the Audit Committee Chair and Board member of SeaCube Container Leasing, the 4th largest container lessor in the world.
