Holly Tyson currently serves as Executive Vice President & Chief People Officer of Cushman & Wakefield, a \$9.4B global commercial real estate and services firm where she leads a team of 550 colleagues responsible for ensuring the company's structures and approaches create an inclusive, talent-focused culture that drives growth through developing, engaging, and deploying 53,000 employees across 60 countries.
